PRINCIPAL'S SPOTLIGHT

Goal 1: Develop and implement high quality curriculum, assessment and instructional practices to support personalized student learning. (multi-year goal)

- Teachers will develop, implement and collaboratively score two Performance Tasks per grade level. (2017-2018)
- Teachers will deepen their understanding of standards-based grading as seen through pre and post staff survey. (2017-2018)
- Teachers will begin to individualize student learning by utilizing Dreambox as seen in usage reports. (2017-2018)

Goal 2: Establish a community, classroom and school-wide, that fosters and ensures the social emotional development and growth of all. (multi-year goal)

- Teacher's trained in Responsive Classroom will implement practices. (Morning Meeting, Quiet Time, Energizers.). Four additional teachers will be trained in Responsive Classroom. (2017-2018)
- School counselor will pilot social-emotional learning curriculum in grade Kindergarten through Eighth grade and submit a survey to reflect on program and implementation. (2017-2018)

Teacher / Leader Effectiveness Evaluations: This year marks our fourth year using this coaching model of observations for all certified staff in the building. Each month updates will be given on the number of informal and formal observations completed to date. Currently we have 23 certified staff to be observed for the 2107-2018 school year.
